On January 26th-29th, twenty-two students and six adults will be traveling to Washington, D.C. with Lutheran High School's Teens for Life Club for the annual March for Life. This will be the 21st year in a row that the LHS club has taken the trip. Every year since the United States Supreme Court legalized abortion in 1973, the March for Life has been held in Washington on or near the anniversary of the decision, sometimes drawing as many as 300,000 people from across the country. In addition to marching, the group will receive education and encouragement at the Students for Life of America Conference.

The March for Life and conference give students a tremendous opportunity to put their convictions into action in a tangible way. God works mightily through the service and enthusiasm of young people, who are energizing the pro-life movement. Students are powerfully impacted by the trip, and return better equipped to stand for life boldly and compassionately in their day-to-day lives.

The trip to Washington D.C. comes with many expenses. Airfare, hotel, conference fees, metro passes, food, and other expenses add up to around \$355 per person. The students are planning multiple fundraisers to help offset the cost. Our Lutherans for Life chapter is helping raise funds for this important trip.
